Bob the man on the moon left some space boots for us! We tried to see how far we could jump in them. We measured the distance and put the results on a pictogram.






What a busy week we have had! On Thursday, we had our first 'Math's Morning' of the new academic year and we based it on 'statistics'. In years 3 and 4 we learnt how to gather data and represent it in a bar chart and a pictogram. We enjoyed using the timers to help us gather the information!



Years 5 and 6 were also busy gathering information and learning how to construct line graphs to display this data. They were able to link their maths work to science by practising reading thermometer scales and measuring how water cooled over ten minutes.
